#### SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Authors should submit the abstracts not exceeding one page and fitting to the needs for publishing in the Book of Abstracts. The format is A4, (210 x 297 mm); all margins 2.5 cm; font – Times New Roman, 12p; title – Bold, All Caps. Language is English. The abstracts may contain graphical results that support the written arguments. Book of Abstracts will be available as a handout during the Conference. Presentation form (oral, poster, either) should be indicated in e-mail letter with attached abstract in MS Word format. The Programme Committee reserves the right to decide on the final allocation and presentation method. After having submitted your abstract, you will receive an e-mail confirmation.
